Marlette Country Fair Days Parade Rules & Regulations

Entrants must observe all applicable rules and regulations and follow instructions from Police and parade officials at all times. Parade Officials and the Marlette Police Department reserve the right to remove any entrant from the parade either prior to or during the parade.

All Vehicles, Tractors, Semis, and other Tow Vehicles must be clean and well maintained.

No entry will be allowed to convey any obscene, inflammatory, and/or offensive message or image. This includes but is not limited to banners, pamphlets, buttons, billboards, signs, flags, music selections, or speeches/announcements.

Participants are allowed to gently toss candy from parade entries. Passengers in vehicles may gently toss candy from the vehicle. DRIVERS of any type of vehicle, including but not limited to cars, trucks, semis, tractors, golf carts, bikes, or tow vehicles, are not allowed to toss candy.

All entries having music or sound amplifying systems shall maintain a volume that will not interfere with other entries, especially those with animals.

Drivers of any and all vehicles in the parade areas must possess a valid driver's license or learner's permit, be at least 16 years old, and possess all liability vehicle insurance. The driver will remain seated in the driver's seat for the duration of the parade. Entries (lawn mowers, mini bikes, mopeds, go-carts, golf carts, etc.) with younger drivers will be required to inform parade officials before the start of the parade.

No one will get on or off a float, trailer, vehicle, or entry once it has started down the parade route.

All animals in the parade must be kept on leashes or harness and held by someone strong enough to manage them. Animals participating in the parade must be kept under control.

Entries involving animals of any kind must provide their own clean-up, or "pooper scooper" immediately following their entry.

Participants under the age of 18 on bicycles, scooters, skates, skateboards, etc. must wear a helmet and proper safety equipment.

Floats/trailers must be secured properly to the tow vehicle.

All vehicular entries shall proceed at a safe and appropriate speed, shall maintain a safe distance from spectators, and shall not weave from side to side unless performing a pre-approved routine.

All participants and applicants, in consideration of participation in this event, agree to indemnify, hold harmless and release the City of Marlette, its agents and employees, from any and all liability for any injury or damage, or loss of property which may arise out of or in any way be connected with participation in the parade or as a result of exclusion from the parade.
